We thank Chief Sloly for his ongoing leadership within the Ottawa Police Service that continues to ensure professionalism, integrity and public confidence are upheld.

The Board is committed to transparency and accountability and will continue to make decisions that earn the highest level of trust in our Police Service and the Board.

The Ottawa Police Services Board is the civilian body responsible for governing the Ottawa Police Service. It is responsible for the provision of adequate and effective police services to the City of Ottawa's residents.
