### **Update: Special Meeting of the Ottawa Police Services Board on February 9, 2023**

(Ottawa) – On February 2, 2023, the Ottawa Police Services Board issued a media release to advise the public that it would be holding a special public meeting on Thursday, February 9, 2023, at 2:00 pm where the City of Ottawa’s Auditor General would be presenting audit reports pertaining to the Ottawa Police Service’s Response to the Convoy Protest.

Prior to the public meeting at 2:00pm, the Board will now be holding an in-camera meeting to receive a briefing from the Chief of Police on potential demonstrations in the month of February.
