After graduating, Robert worked as a management consultant helping several clients with business process re-engineering, logistics and e-commerce. After a seven-year career as a management consultant, Robert returned to Ottawa and entered the hospitality industry and land development. Building on best practices he developed as a management consultant, Robert applied his knowledge in various commercial developments. This led him to become his own general contractor and entrepreneur. He has opened several businesses in the hospitality, property development/management, and film industry.

Robert has always had a strong passion for community involvement. As an executive on the Board of his church, Robert oversaw many initiatives that have helped raised money for his church, local charities and overseas humanitarian efforts. Most notably, for several years, Robert was the Chair of one of Ottawa's largest festivals, the Lebanese Fun Festival. Robert went on to be the Chair of The Dewaan Foundation, a local cultural philanthropy group that raises millions for organizations such as The Ottawa Hospital, Ottawa Regional Cancer Society, Bruyère Continuing Care and many other local charities.
